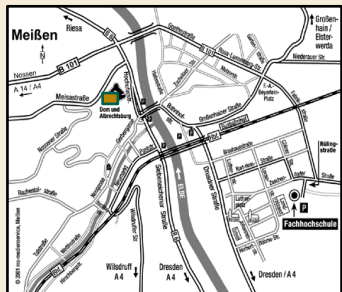
Recognition of Continuing Education

Classics Meet Complexity:**The Bridge Between Hahnemann and Today: Intercurrent Remedies, Schüssler Salts, Mammalian & Lesser-Known Remedies in Therapy-Resistant Bone, Joint, and Dermatological Cases**

In complex homeopathic practice, therapeutic plateaus frequently occur despite a correct constitutional prescription. This seminar presents advanced clinical strategies—rooted in years of experience—designed to help overcome such blockages. The central focus is on the targeted use of nosodes in chronic and treatment-resistant cases, illustrated through brief, practical case examples. Topics covered include vaccine nosodes (Vaccinum, Variolinum, Malandrinum); Staphylococcinum for complicated infections and abscesses; the osteoarthritis nosode for knee arthrosis; tuberculinic nosodes such as Bacillinum and Tuberculinum aviare; and Scirrhinum as a deep-acting remedy—particularly when Carcinosinum is no longer effective. Additionally, lesser-known nosodes will be introduced.

Another key focus lies on the growing importance of bowel (or intestinal) nosodes—especially in cases where even classic nosodes fail to produce results and there is evidence of intestinal involvement. *Bacillus sycoccus* (SYC-CO) is highlighted as a vital remedy when *Thuja* and *Medorrhinum* prove ineffective.

Furthermore, modern, flexible prescribing approaches utilizing sarcodes—such as *Testes* and *Thyroidinum*—will be presented, alongside the rediscovery of forgotten remedies found in classical homeopathic literature. Finally, the seminar will address the treatment of hypertension involving renal complications; the significance of the Apocynaceae family in cases of hypertension accompanied by edema (featuring remedies such as *Strophanthus hispidus* and *Quebracho*); and the therapeutic management of goiter and thyroid disorders—specifically utilizing *Lycopus virginicus* from the Labiatae (Lamiaceae) family.
